Background and Context

The Indo-Pacific region has become a central feature of any discussion on international relations. Countries within and beyond the Indo-Pacific region have realised its strategic importance in global geopolitics. As the governments of these countries navigate closer cooperation on security, strategic, and economic issues, non-governmental stakeholders should also actively participate to shape the discourse.

In particular, there is immense scope for positive collaboration among civil society organisations (CSOs) to complement the efforts at the inter-governmental level towards greater synergy in the Indo-Pacific.

The <u>Indo-Pacific Civil Society Forum</u> (IPCSF), an initiative of CUTS International to advance these objectives, will be formally launched at this virtual event. As a network of CSOs in the Indo-Pacific region, IPCSF will act as an enduring platform for advocacy on important issues common to the Indo-Pacific region.

Expected Outcomes

- A platform for free-flowing interactions, discussions and collaborations between stakeholders in the region, including CSOs, government organisations, and think tanks, among others
- Institutionalise the sharing of lessons and experiences gained by CSOs working in individual countries of the region
